

**LUZERNE-WYOMING COUNTIES

Contract No. 13/14-080

Agreement is entered into this 15th day of July, 2013 between Luzerne-Wyoming Counties Mental Health and Developmental Services and
Luzerne County Transportation Authority

hereinafter referred to as the "Provider".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Mental Health and Intellectual Disabilities Act of 1966 (Mental Health/Mental Retardation Act of October 20, 1966, P. L. 96), and subsequent Acts, Amendments, and Regulations, mandate the County, or more than one County to join together to provide services for the mentally ill and intellectually disabled; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Luzerne County and Commissioners of Wyoming County have joined together as the Local Authorities of Luzerne-Wyoming Counties Mental Health and Developmental Services, under which services for the mentally ill and intellectually disabled residents of Luzerne and Wyoming Counties shall be provided:

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereunto intending to be legally bound do hereby agree as follows:

1. This Agreement is subject to all applicable provisions of State and Federal laws and regulations relating to the delivery and funding of mental health and/or developmental services and Provider agrees that it shall be in full compliance with such laws and regulations throughout the term of this Agreement and any extensions or renewals thereof.
2. The term of this Agreement shall be July 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013.
3. All services contracted for hereunder shall be provided in accordance with Mental Health and Development Services currently effective and DPW approved, Annual Plan (incorporated herein by reference), copies of which are on file at the Mental Health and Developmental Services Office, and the Department of Public Welfare's Offices of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and Developmental Programs.
4. The Provider shall provide those services specifically set forth in the appendices attached hereto—within and/or from facility locations approved in advance by Mental Health and Developmental Services and licensed for the delivery of same by the Department of Public Welfare.
5. Subject to Provider's compliance with the terms of this Agreement and the possession by Mental Health and Developmental Services of available and sufficient funds for the program and services contracted for hereunder, the Mental Health and Developmental Services Office shall reimburse the Provider up to the maximum contracted costs as indicated in Appendix A hereto and/or Amendments in accordance with payment provisions outlined herein:
