

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) GOAL FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2017-2019**

As a recipient of United States Department of Transportation (DOT/FTA) funds, the Luzerne County Transportation Authority is required to establish a DBE participation goal.

The Luzerne County Transportation Authority (the "LCTA") in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT/FTA), 49 CFR Part 26, hereby announces its proposed goal of 0.30% for DBE participation on contracts assisted by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for FFY 2017 to 2019.

Information relating to the proposed goal, including its methodology and how it was calculated, are available for public review and inspection for the next 30 days, from the published date of this notice. The public is able to review the DBE program and goal methodology during normal business hours from 9:00AM to 4:00PM (EST), Monday through Friday, at the Luzerne County Transportation Authority, Administrative Offices, 315 Northampton Street, Kingston, PA 18704.

Written comments on this proposed goal will be accepted for 30 days from the published date of this notice until the close of business on July 23, 2017.
