

SUBJECT: Inter-County Comparable Paratransit Service as per ADA of 1990

CONTRACTORS: COLTS AND LCTA

Effective March 1, 2014 a continuation of the July 8, 1992 agreement binding LCTA (Luzerne County Transportation Authority) and COLTS (County of Lackawanna Transit System) to continue to provide ADA paratransit trips to the agreed upon transfer point at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre International Airport. This agreement binds both parties to provide service that complies with US DOT regulations governing the reservation, scheduling, and provision of ADA (STEP) paratransit service.

It is agreed that the designated transfer point for individuals who desire to travel from one county to the other will be at the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport.

SPAN OF SERVICE – The first pickup (interchange of passengers at Wilkes-Barre/Scranton International Airport) will be no earlier than 7:30 a.m. and the last pickup will be no later than 5:00 p.m. for the return trip to the originating county. The service is to be provided during the same days of operation as COLTS and LCTA.

FARES – A special ticket will be available for the Inter-County service at a cost of \$3.75 each way; i.e. \$7.50 round trip.

It is to be noted that the span of service and fares will be reviewed by all parties involved as this service evolves. Depending on demand, costs of operation, and availability of subsidies, revisions in service times and/or fares may occur. Any such change will be advertised and open to public comment.
