Veterans should show the bus driver their Military ID Card; VA Medical Card or Certificate of Discharge. They will then receive their commemorative pin, which will serve as their "Bus Ticket" for the entire day! In addition; LCTA will host a special table at the Intermodal Center in Wilkes-Barre from 9AM until 11:30 AM. All veterans visiting the table will receive a small lunch tote, (while supplies last) with a veteran's pin, a drink, and a snack. Also, because of the generosity of McDonald's/Pat Stella, the lunch tote will also have a certificate for a FREE cheeseburger from participating McDonald's in NEPA.
