



Video Surveillance Policy

All LCTA public transportation vehicles and properties have a multi-view video and audio recording system installed. This system records a minimum of five to as many as eight separate areas inside and outside the vehicle. All of our active fleet is monitored by electronic video and audio surveillance equipment. The presence of this equipment contributes to a safer environment for you, our customer.

For your safety and security, your picture and voice may be recorded while onboard an LCTA vehicle. Your decision to board an LCTA vehicle is your consent to these recordings, and you acknowledge that your image and/or voice may be recorded by the on-board surveillance system.

LCTA uses these surveillance devices and footage for a variety of operational reasons, and your image or voice may be used for any such purpose-including fulfilling requests for video/audio recordings for Right-to-Know Request purposes.

These video and audio recordings are overwritten and no longer available for viewing on the hard drive anywhere from one week to three weeks (depending on how often the vehicle is used). LCTA does not keep or maintain archive data on all recordings, only those that involve a significant reported incident.

LCTA's Audio/Video Recording and Maintenance Policy is maintained on file at the LCTA Administrative Office in Kingston, PA.
